



Bunting

Large Triangle, Triangle
Rounded Rectangle,
Rectangle



1. Cut all corresponding paper pattern pieces.

Cut out pattern pieces out of your chosen fabric, cut as many bunting flags as you need.

To create the bunting string, cut a rectangle that is 2inch and as long as you require for the bunting.



2. Taking the string piece, fold in half lengthways, press in place. Open up the fold, and fold in the two raw edges to the centre fold. Press in place.

Put aside the string for later.



3. Place two bunting pieces, right sides together. Pin or clip in place. Using a 1/2inch seam allowance, sew down one side and up the other. Leaving the top open to turn through.

Trim off the excess seam allowance, being careful not to cut any stitches.

Turn through, ensuring the corners are nice and sharp. Top stitch around the edge.

Repeat for as many bunting flags as required.



4. Taking the string binding place the bunting inside the folds to conceal the raw edges. Pin or clip in place.

Repeat for the remaining flags, ensuring the gaps between each flag is equal.



5. Top stitch along one edge of the sting binding ensuring to catch each of the flags as you go.

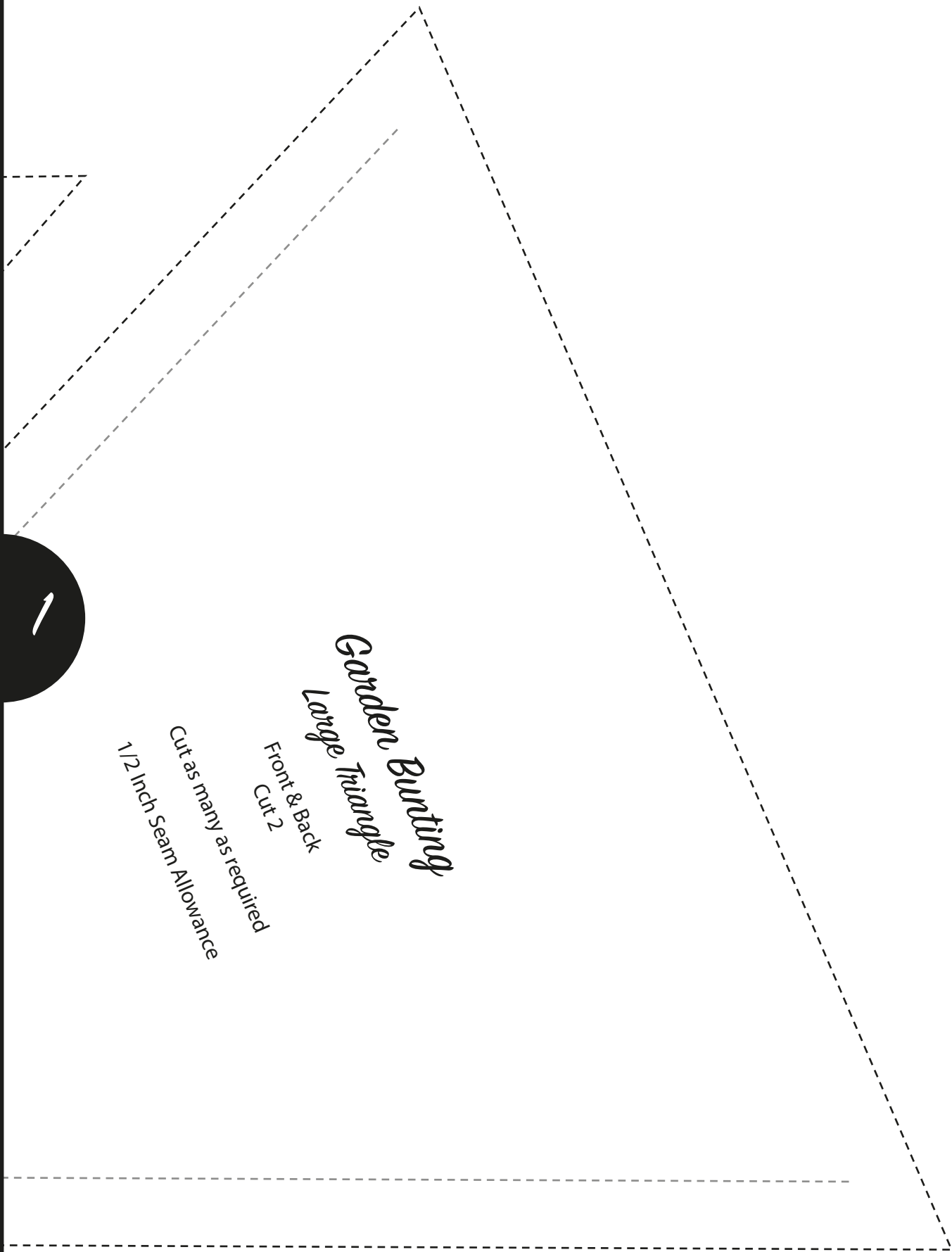
At the far end stitch carefully along the short edge of the binding and continue along the other side of the string binding.

Give everything one last press and your bunting is now complete.

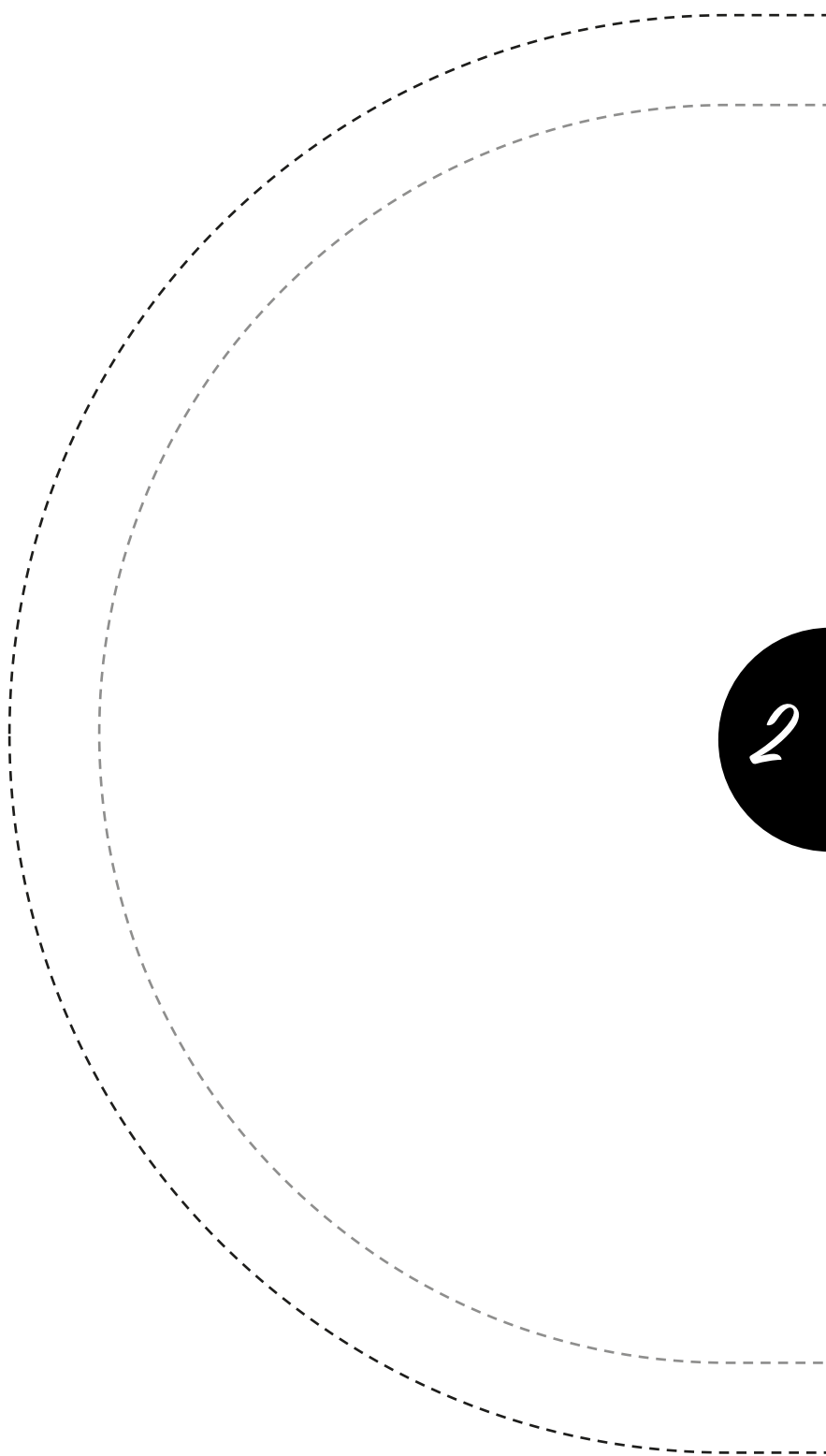
